2. Inspiration- “God-breathed”= God’s Word(s) There can be no doubt that this Word is authoritative. *Deuteronomy 4:1-2; Proverbs 30:5-6; Matthew 5:17-20; James 4:17; Revelation 22:16-20. John 8:31-32*
3. Infallibility- the state of being incapable of mistakes or being wrong *Psalms 119:143; Romans 3:3-4; 1 Peter 1:22-25 cf John 10:35*
4. Inerrant- incapable of being wrong. Scripture is the Word of God. God is unable to lie or be in error. Therefore Scripture is without error. *Numbers 23:19; 1 Samuel 15:29; Proverbs 30:5-7 cf Titus 1:1-3; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:16-21*
5. Sufficient- enough, adequate. *Isaiah 8:20; 2 Timothy 3:16-4:5; Psalm 19:1-13; Acts 20:32; 2 Peter 1:16-21*
